YOUTH EXCHANGE will take place in Nurri From 22nd - 30th of August 2024









- To explore EU opportunities and policies about raising active awareness of European Citizenship
- To tackle the future of the EU, it's place and weight in the world and priorities according to youth
- To create a network of young people that are interested in shaping the future of Europe as a player in the global picture, raising awareness and sense of belonging to the union in youngsters
- To simulate and understand the processes of democracy and concept of active citizenship through outdoor activities



This youth exchange is made in order to talk about which place the EU should occupy in the world according to young people's perspective. Through outdoor activities foster participation of young people in their community and in political life on local, national, European and global level, boost their sense of belonging to European Union and ensure their participation in democracy processes.

"A growing number of young people who no longer trust the EU find it difficult to understand its principles, values and functioning. The democratic deficit in EU processes is also one of the reasons for the rise of Euroscepticism among young people", it is recalled in the explanatory context of the YouthGoal 1, Connecting EU with youth.

younger generations are one of the groups that by statistics are participating less in the EU's democratic life therefore in it's future positioning in a global picture. So, with this youth exchange we would like to tackle these issues by involving young people coming from Italy, France, Poland, Portugal and Greece to talk and work with creativity and through appositely designed outdoor activities on questions

such as what place do young people want Europe to play in the world? what are the challenges and issues of today and tomorrow? And to help them identify their link with the EU, its values and its democratic foundations, in a word to accompany them in becoming actively aware of their European citizenship.









We will discuss the topics mentioned above using outdoor education, digital tools and traditional methods based on non-formal education and in particular peer-to-peer education. Learners centred and young people will be protagonists, every country group will be responsible to run its own session based on an agenda which will be defined during the preparatory visit.
